

**Gimme 5 Atlanta
R8 - Social Norms Protocol
(Day 5)**

[To be read as written!]

"We passed out the last questionnaire for today. On this one, we want to find out what your family thinks about what you eat and what kids your age think about what they eat. Please write in your name, (pause); today's date which is _____, (pause); and your teacher's name at the top of both pages."

[Allow time; Rover(s) check that students are doing this]

"On page 1 we want to know what your family thinks about your eating fruits and vegetables. There are no right or wrong answers to these questions. We just want to know what your family thinks about what you eat."

"You will notice that under each question it says **Answer here** on the white line. This is where you will mark your answer under the "A", "B", "C" or "D" column. To do this, you will darken the circle in column A if you agree with answer A below the question.

Or, you will darken the circle in column B if you agree with answer B.

Or, you will darken the circle in column C if you agree with answer C.

Or, you will darken the circle in column D if you agree with answer D."

"You will fill in only one circle on the line where it says **Answer here**. Are there any questions about what I've said so far?"

[Answer and record questions]

"I will read question 1 on the first page. Please listen carefully and follow along with your finger as I read."

[Read question 1]

"Now listen as I read the responses A through D under question 1. As I am reading them, be sure to pick out the one that best describes what your family thinks about you eating 2 or more servings of fruit or juice each day. You will fill in the appropriate lettered circle on the white line next to where it says "Answer here"."

[Read responses A through D slowly, saying each letter as you read them.]

"Now you need to fill in the circle of the letter that best describes your answer to question 1."

[Allow time; Rover(s) check(s) each student's page to make sure he/she is doing this correctly.]

"Are there any questions?"

[Answer and record questions]

"Okay, let's go on to question 2."

[Read question 2.]

"Now listen as I read the responses A through D under question 2. You will fill in the appropriate lettered circle on the white line next to where it says "Answer here"."

[Read responses A through D slowly, saying each letter as you read them.]

"Now you need to fill in the circle of the letter that best describes your answer to question 2."

[Allow time; Rover(s) check(s) each student's page to make sure he/she is doing this correctly.]

"Is everyone finished with this page?"

[If no, allow time; if yes, go on]

Let's go to page 2 now. The questions on this page are about what kids your age think about what they eat. There are no right or wrong answers to these questions. We just want to know what you think kids your age think about what they eat. Are there any questions?"

[Answer and record questions]

"Okay, let's go on to question 3."

[Read question 3.]

"Now listen as I read the responses A through D under question 3. As I am reading them, be sure to pick out the one that best describes what kids your age think about you eating 2 or more servings of fruit and juices each day. You will fill in the appropriate lettered circle on the white line next to where it says "Answer here"."

[Read responses A through D slowly, saying each letter as you read them.]

"Are there any questions?"

[Answer and record questions]

"Okay, let's go on to question 4."

[Read question 4.]

"Now listen as I read the responses A through D under question 4. You will fill in the appropriate lettered circle on the white line next to where it says "Answer here"."

[Read responses A through D slowly, saying each letter as you read them.]

"Is everyone finished with this page?"

[If no, allow time; if yes, go on]

"Please check that you have:

- written your name, teacher's name, and date on both pages and
- answered each question with only one answer -- and on the white line marked

Answer here."

Please lay your paper on the corner of your desk when you are finished. We will come by and pick them up."

[Pick up papers and carefully check that:

- name, teacher's name, and date are on the top of both pages and
- all questions are answered on the white lines and with only one response.]

"Just like we promised, we have a surprise for each of you who completed your diary and filled out the questionnaires today. Please sit quietly while we pass them out."

[Rover(s) and Reader pass out trinkets, one to each child who has completed his/her diary and filled out the questionnaires.]
